Time Commitment

- A minimum of one day a week for one academic year is required.

Qualifications

- You must be a trainee counsellor/psychotherapist and be enrolled on a recognised professional training course (Diploma Level 4 or higher)
- You must be a student member of a professional membership body (e.g., UKCP or BACP) and agree to work within the terms of the BACP Ethical Framework.
- Must have written evidence from your college or university tutor to confirm you are ready for a clinical placement.

Training and Support

- Volunteer Induction Programme which includes Mandatory Training and should be completed before commencing the role.
- Supervision and further CPD training will be given.
